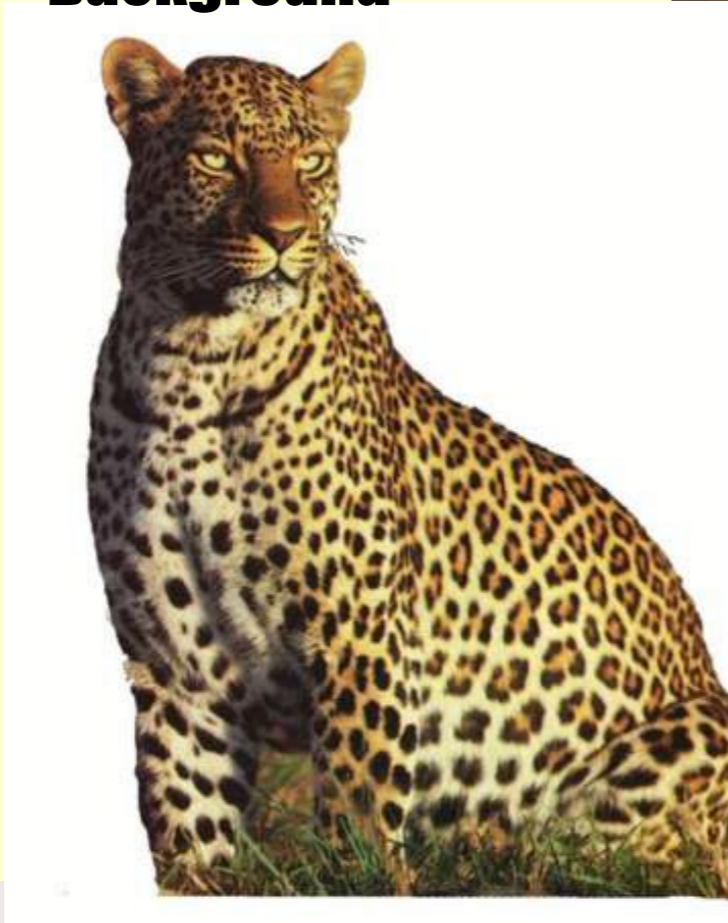

QuarkXPress Workshop
Opening a Document
 When opening a document that was created using different settings than the current system is using, select *Keep Document Settings* to maintain proper settings and formatting.
The Four Tools You Must Use
 Item Tool - Selects, moves, resizes, and reshapes items (boxes, lines, text paths, and groups), and reshapes rounded corners.
 Content Tool - Imports and edits text and pictures.
 Text Box Tool - Use this to make text boxes. The default is the Rectangular Text Box, which provides access to other text box tools.
 Picture Box Tool - Use this to make picture boxes. The default is the Rectangular Picture Box, which provides access to other picture box tools.

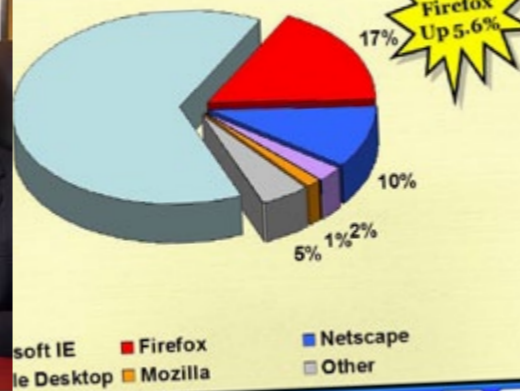
